### Triball Season to kick off in 01 809

The soon to be formed Mangalian Triball League will host a series of trials over the next couple of months. The Administrator of this league is a bloke whose name might be familiar to some longer term players, namely Jeff Perkins. When the League opens in 01 809 it will comprise a season that coincides with a TN year. It will run in the "off processing week" and will offer a TN related activity for players experiencing withdrawal. Depending on the number of players interested the League will comprise a number of Conferences of either 4 or 8 teams. The trialling will require neither people, horses nor equipment as such. However, when playing the season proper though each side will require 50 Warriors, 50 Horses and 50 Clubs or Heaters. These items will be available for a normal TN turn. We are looking for 4 to 8 volunteers to kick-off pretty well immediately. Should there be a flood of interest we will take the first 8 Clans as they announce themselves - with a maximum of 4 Australian players. Modest rewards will accrue to the seasonal winner(s) but

the main incentive is the prospect of being in the vanguard of the celebratory cavalcade as it winds its way through the streets of Shanghia and the celebrity it brings.

### **Elements**

Free Element for new players.

New players are entitled to one Element (split from the main Tribe free of any Admin levels (that is, at AdmO). And also the Trade Element. So if you have a Trade Element, a free Element and 2 normal Elements your main Tribe is entitled to four Elements.




The Messenger of the Elemental Clan:
